REGISTER TO VOTE

YOU MAY REGISTER TO VOTE IF YOU:

- currently are a United States Citizen;
- will be at least 18 years of age at the time of the next election; and
- are not in prison or on parole for a felony.

HOW AND WHERE TO REGISTER

You may register by completing a registration-by-mail form. Forms are available throughout the City of Los Angeles including fire stations, libraries, State Motor Vehicle Offices, Public Assistance Offices (DPSS, WIC), banks, post offices, community organizations, and in most Los Angeles County buildings.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

RE-REGISTRATION

If you have permanently moved to a different address, changed your name, or wish to change your political party affiliation you must re-register to vote.

DID YOU KNOW?
The deadline to register to vote is 15 days before an election.

VOTE-BY-MAIL

APPLY TO BE A VOTE-BY-MAIL VOTER

Explore the benefits of voting by mail. Simply use the application included on the back cover of your Official Sample Ballot.

Vote-By-Mail applications must be submitted for each election and received by the elections office no later than 7 days prior to the election.

As an alternative to submitting an application, you may also request a mail ballot by submitting a letter with the name and date of the election and your registered address and signature.

PERMANENT VOTE-BY-MAIL VOTER

You can also choose to become a permanent Vote-By-Mail voter. As a permanent Vote-By-Mail voter, you will no longer have to apply to Vote-By-Mail for future elections. A Ballot will automatically be mailed to you for each election in which you are eligible to vote.

VOTER SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Audio recordings of the information printed in ballot pamphlets are available for voters upon request. The recordings are available approximately three weeks before the election and may be obtained by calling the Election Division at (213) 978-0444.
