


WE NEED YOUR HELP




SIDEWALK & PARKWAY MAINTENANCE

Sidewalk and Parkway's Maintenance are Property Owner's Responsibility.

Parkways are city rights-of-ways and contain various buried utilities. In most residential areas the parkway is the land between the curb and sidewalk.

Residents are responsible for mowing and maintaining their parkway. If the home is on a corner lot or backs to another roadway, residents are required to mow the parkway on the side or rear of their home, even if the parkway is behind a fence. The parkway must be kept free of weeds, vines, brush or other growth and debris and to keep the parkway free of obstructions or depressions which might be injurious to the general public.

DID YOU KNOW

Your property line goes beyond your block wall, fence or yard to include the sidewalk and parkway along the street.

LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE LAMC 56.08 SECTION (C) STATES:

Owners to keep sidewalk and parkways clear of all

- Debris, vegetation overgrowth, and trash
- Tree overhang can not obstruct the free passage of pedestrians
- Trees and vegetation must not hang lower than 9ft. over



IT'S THE LAW

LAMC 56.08, section (c) states:

No person having charge or control of any lot or premises shall allow any soil, rubbish, trash, garden refuse, tree trimmings, asks, cans or other waste or refuse to remain upon any sidewalk parkway or in or upon any street abutting on or adjacent to such lot or premises, or which will interfere with or obstruct the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles along any such street, sidewalk or par

Failure to adhere to the ordinance can result in fines from \$50 - \$150 and possible prosecution as a misdemeanor if violations continue.
