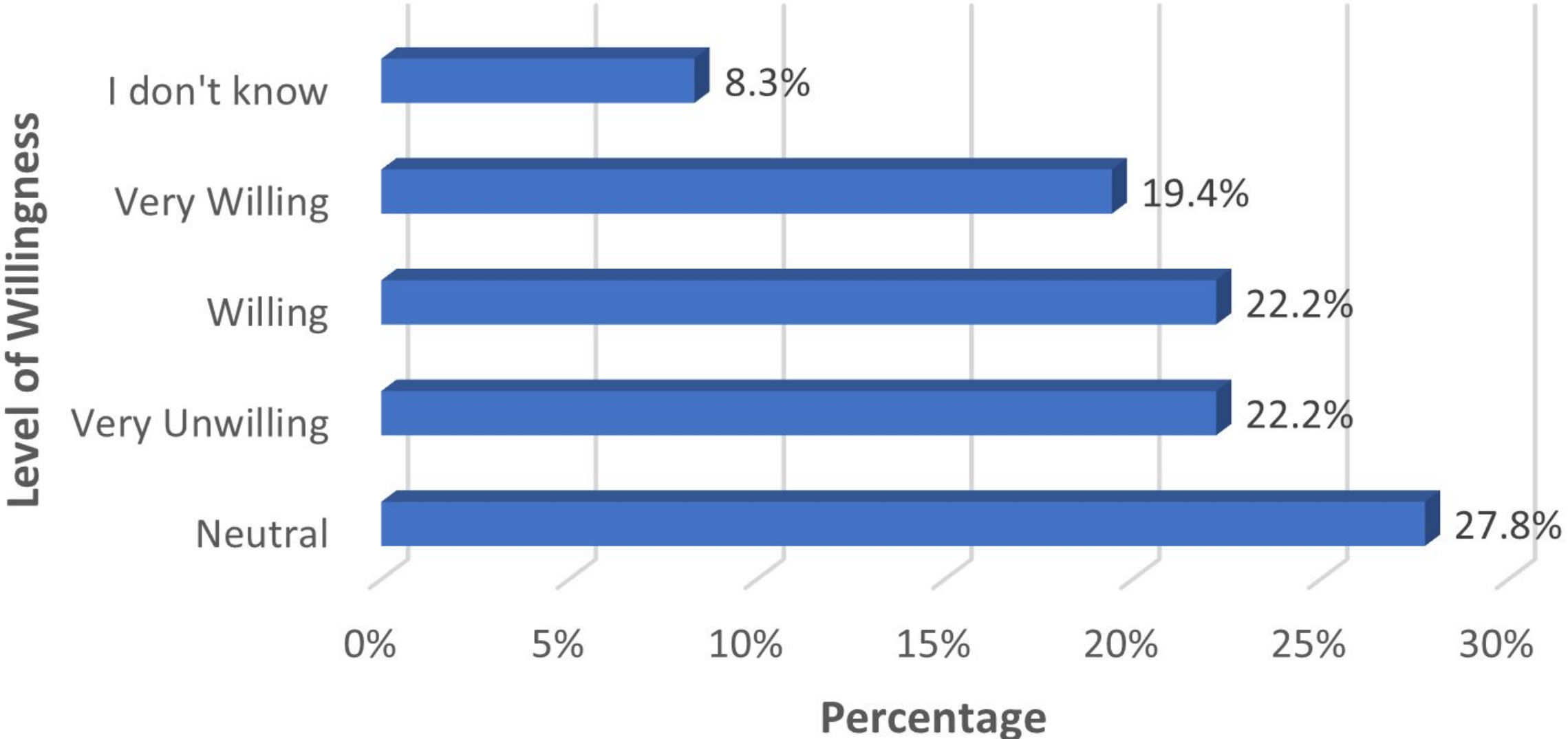


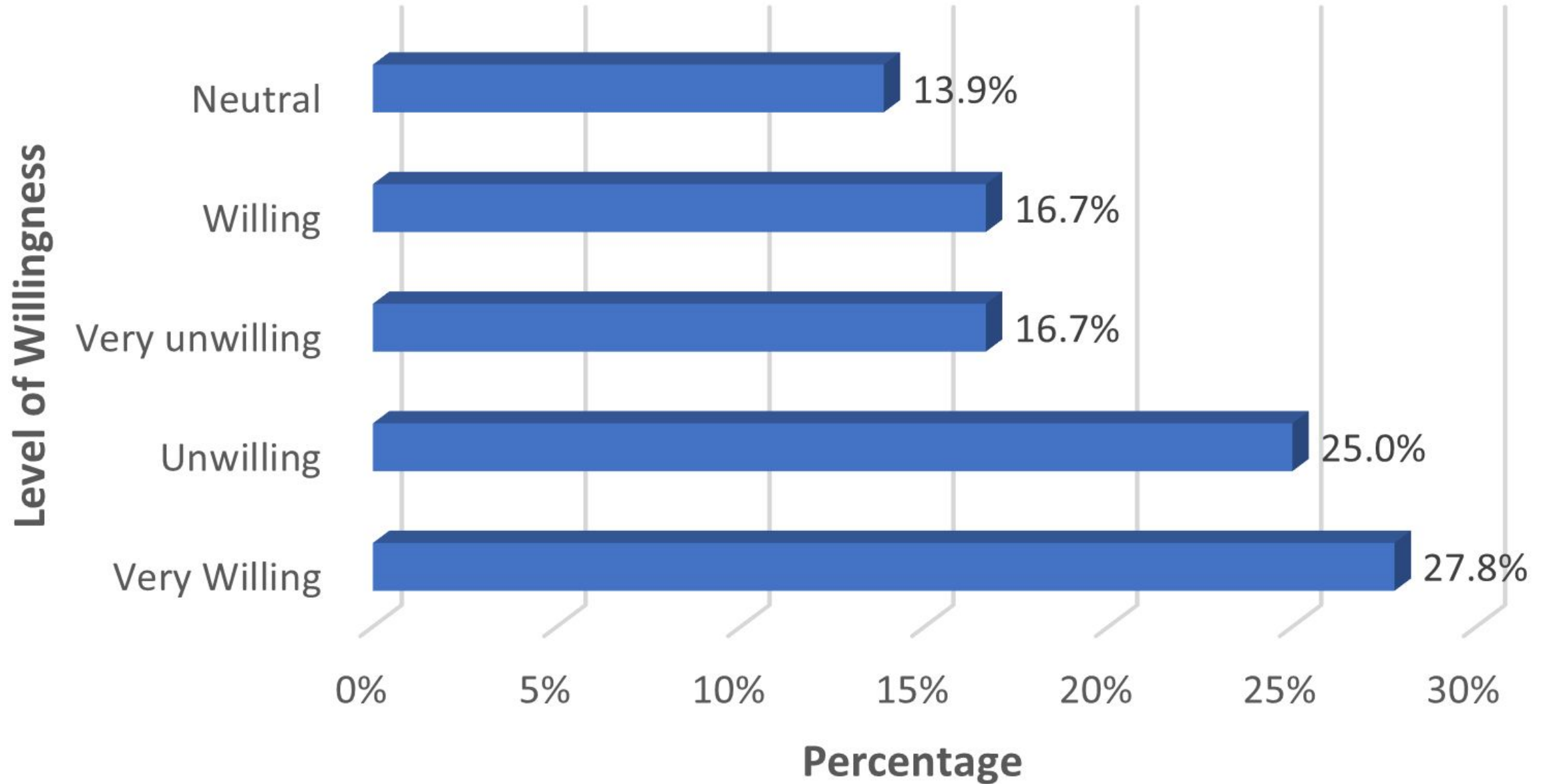

Respondent perception about how willing their Board is to return to in-person meetings

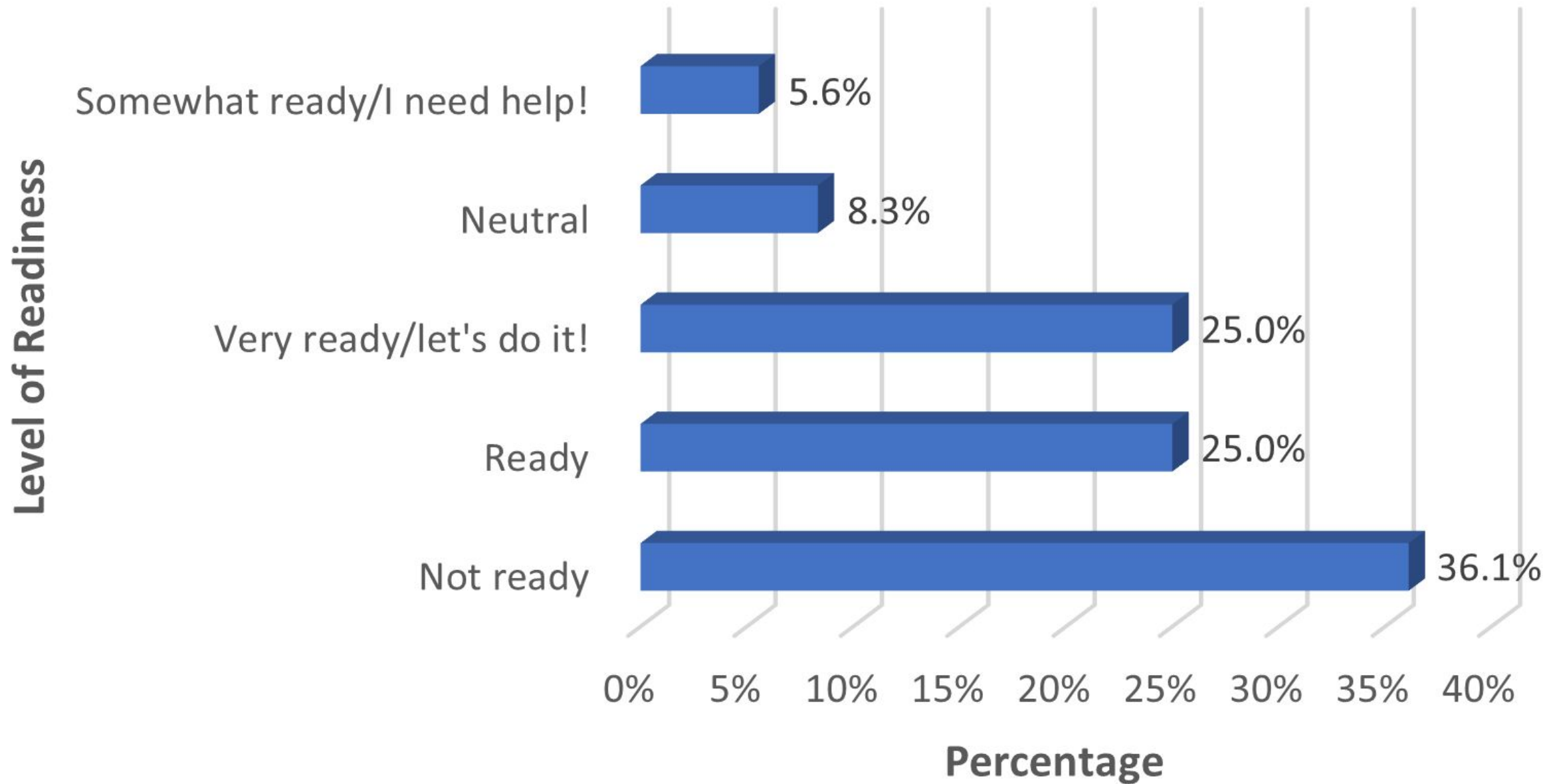


Respondent willingness to attend in-person meetings



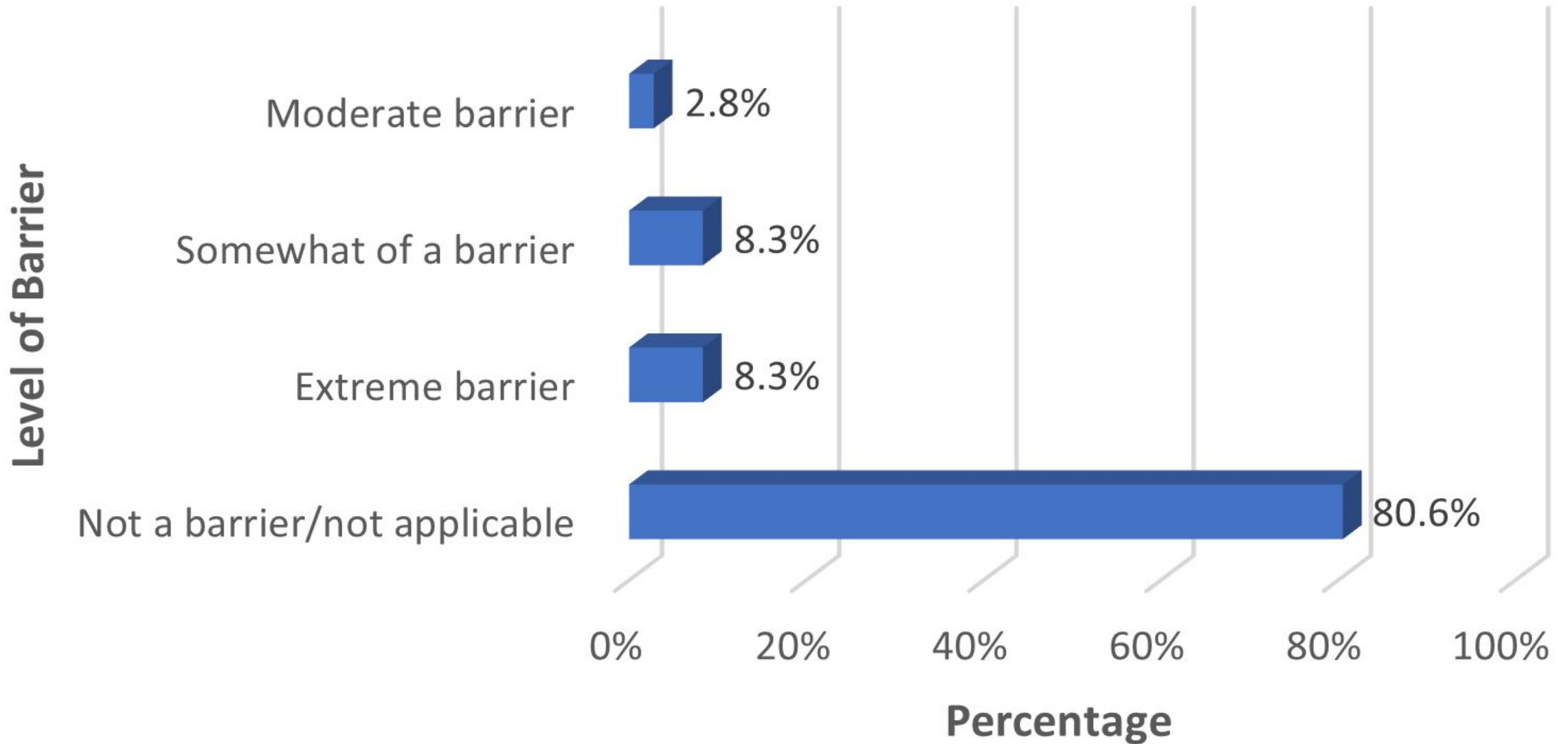
Readiness

Respondent readiness to attend in-person meetings

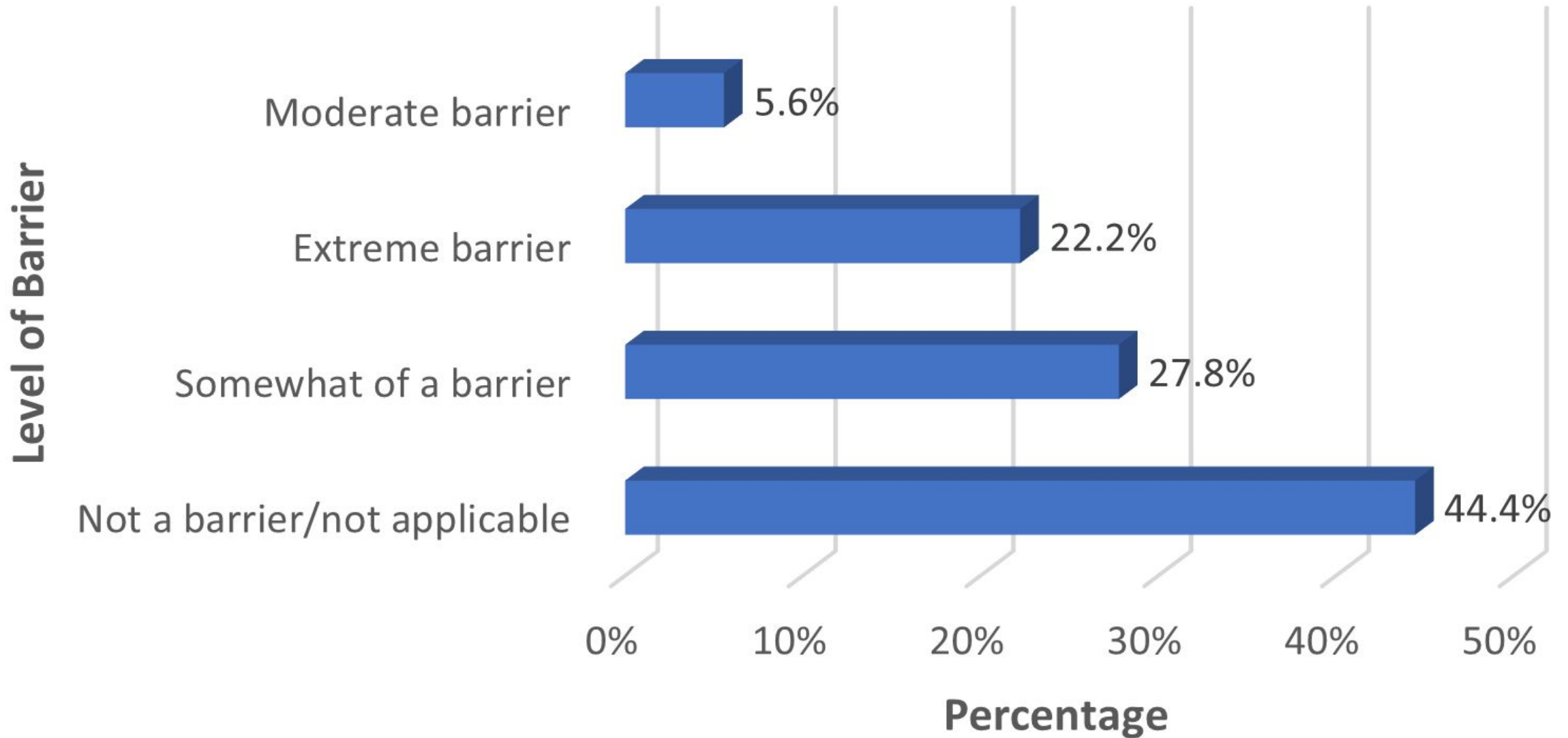

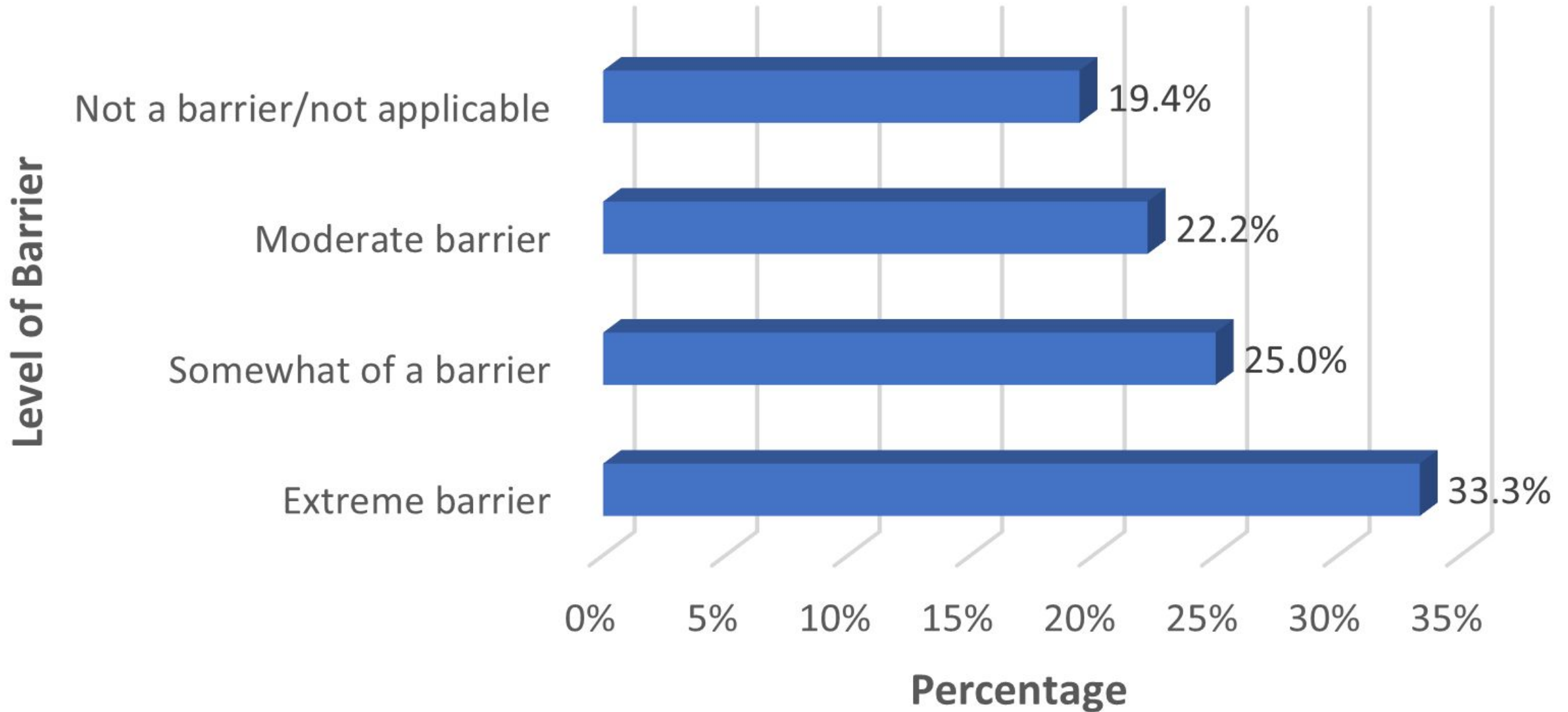
Barriers to return to in-person meetings: childcare and/or eldercare



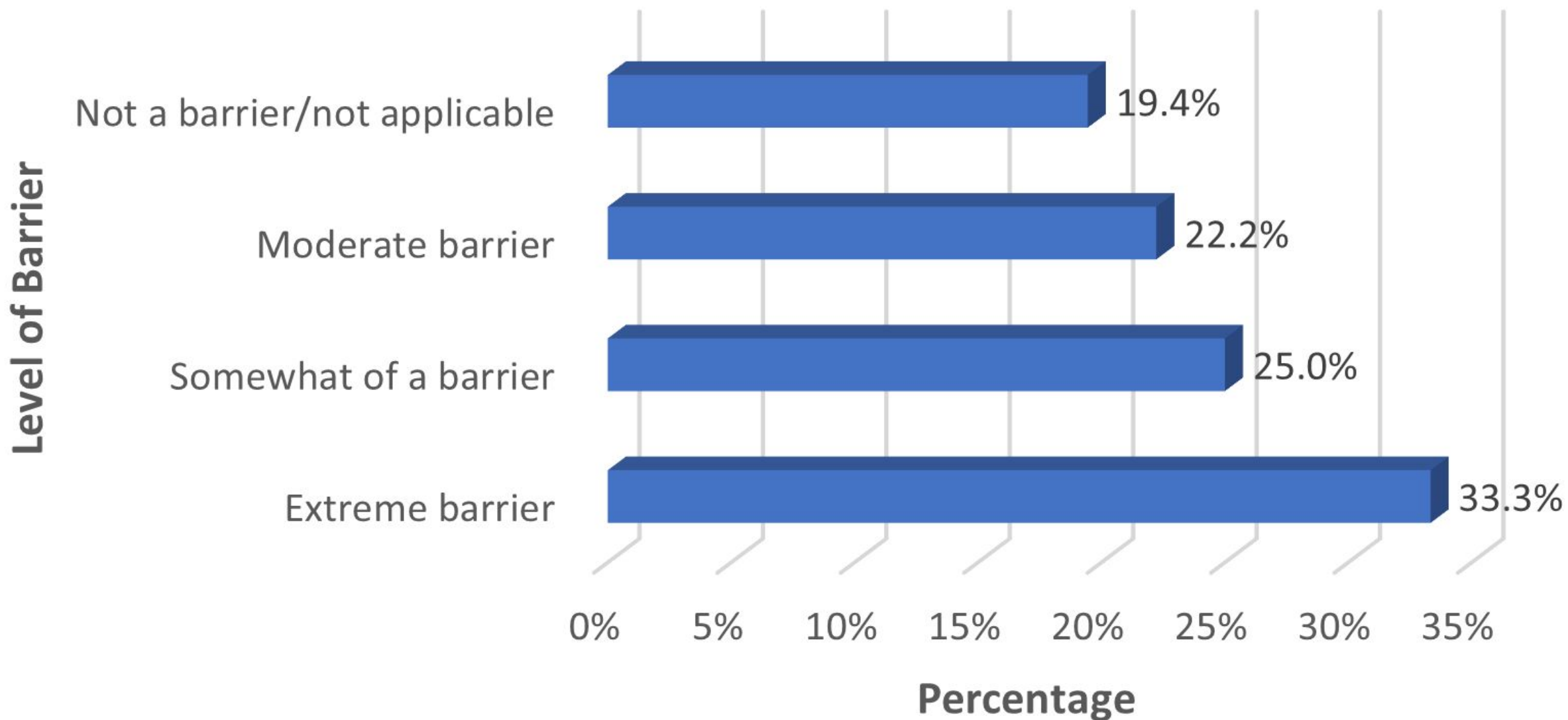
Barriers to return to in-person meetings: time constraints (work and/or school)



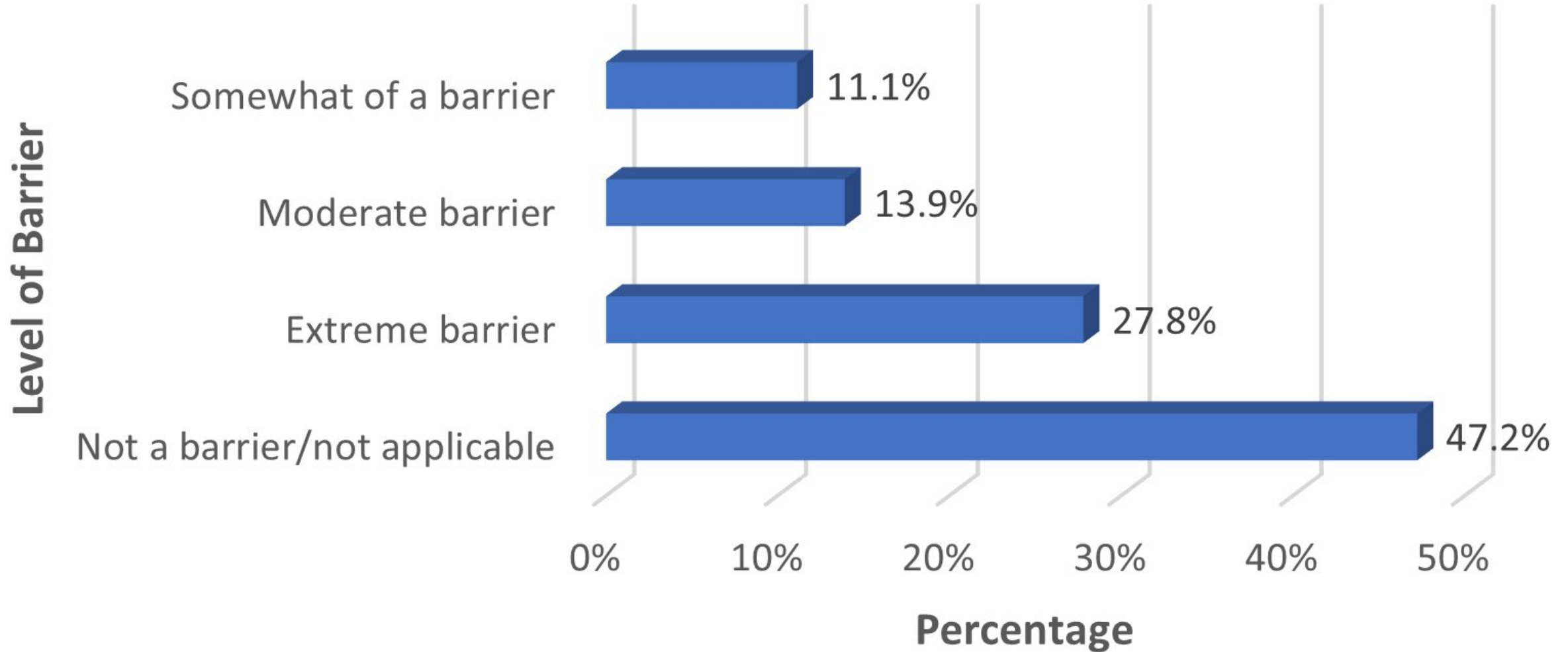
Barriers to return to in-person meetings: distance/transportation constraints



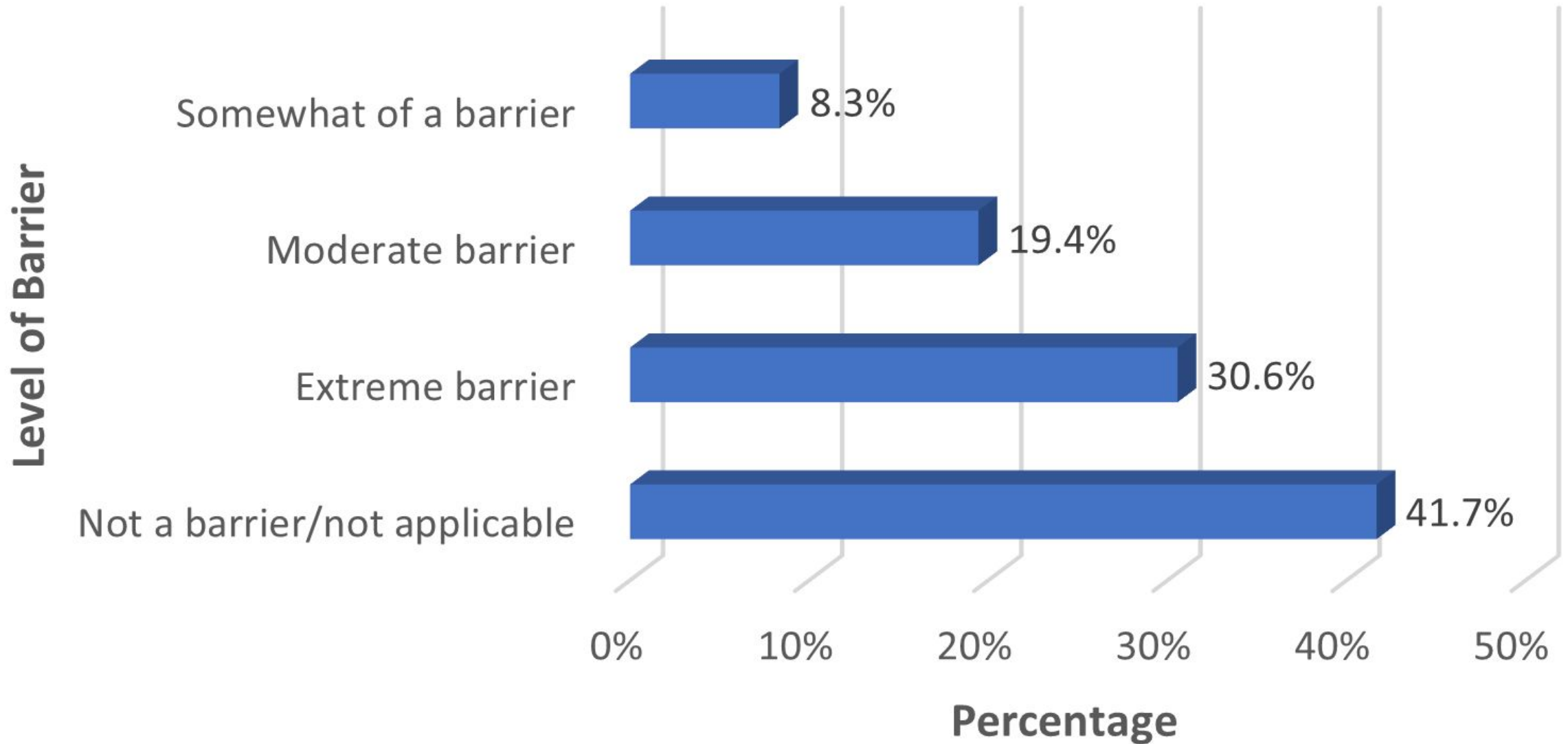
Barriers to return to in-person meetings: COVID exposure concerns



Barriers to return to in-person meetings: following health and safety regulations (masking and vaccination requirements)

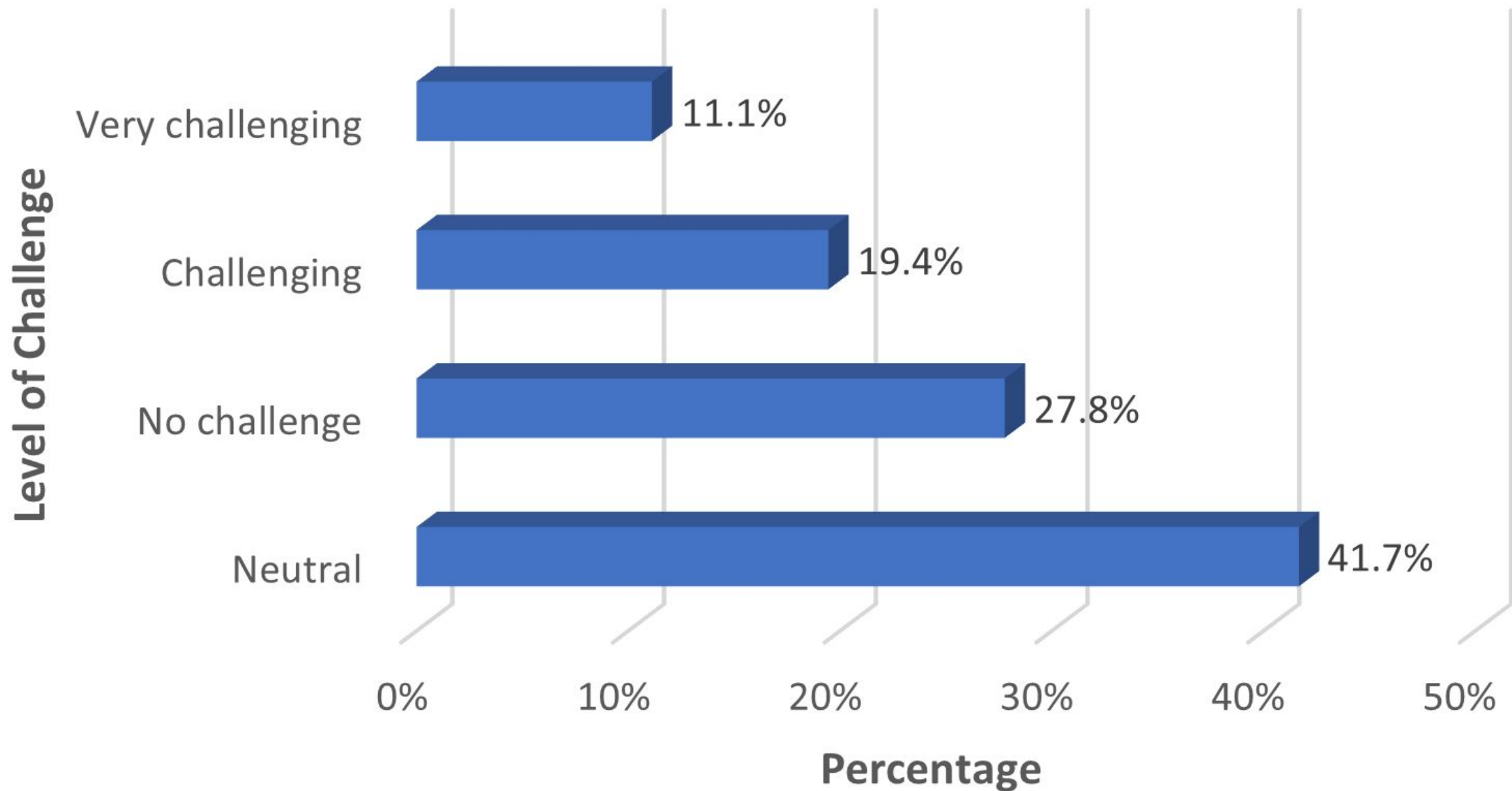


Barriers to return to in-person meetings: personal safety concerns (non-COVID related)

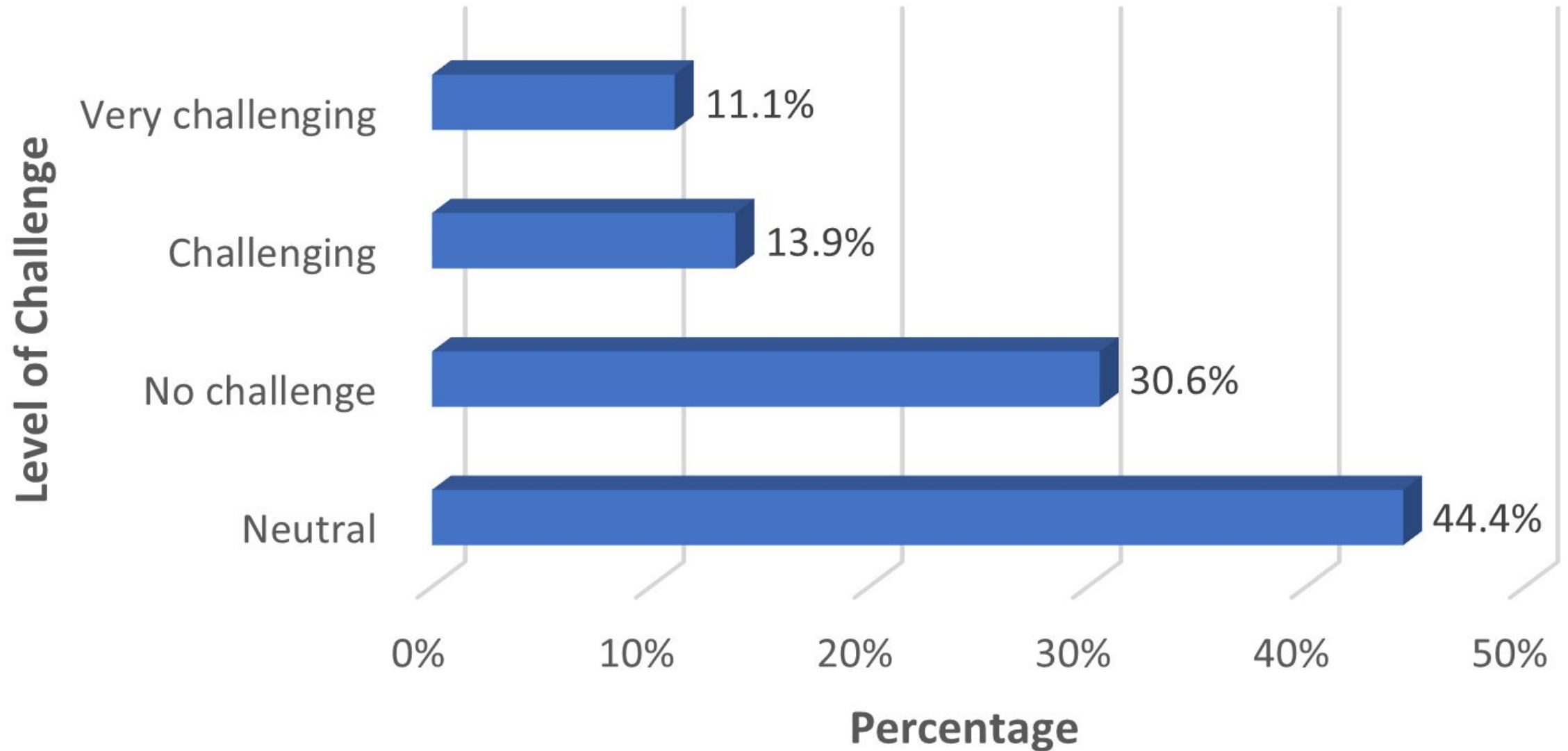

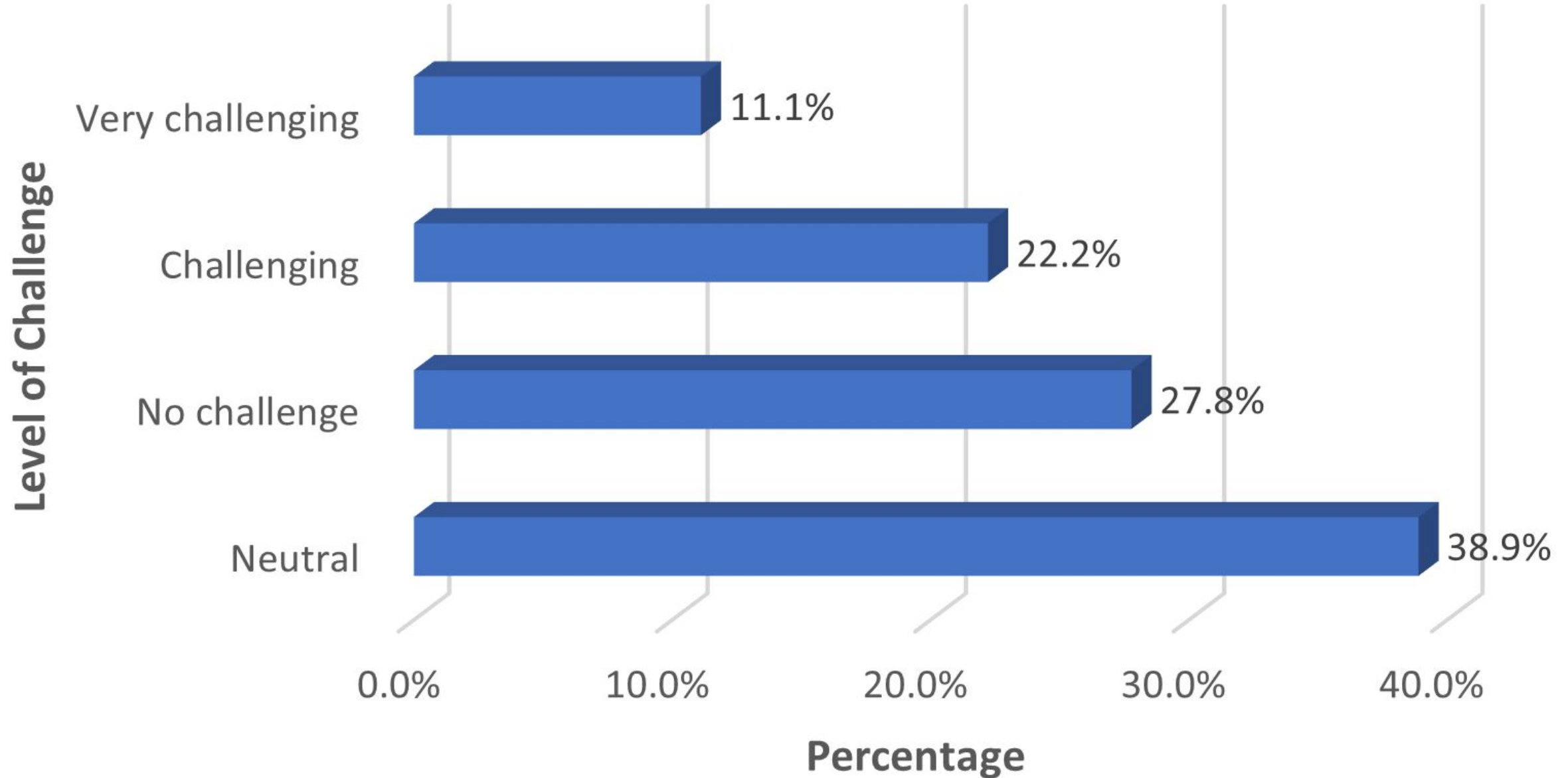
Familiarity with using and/or setting up tech during meetings



My Neighborhood Council's equipment management protocols and storage arrangements



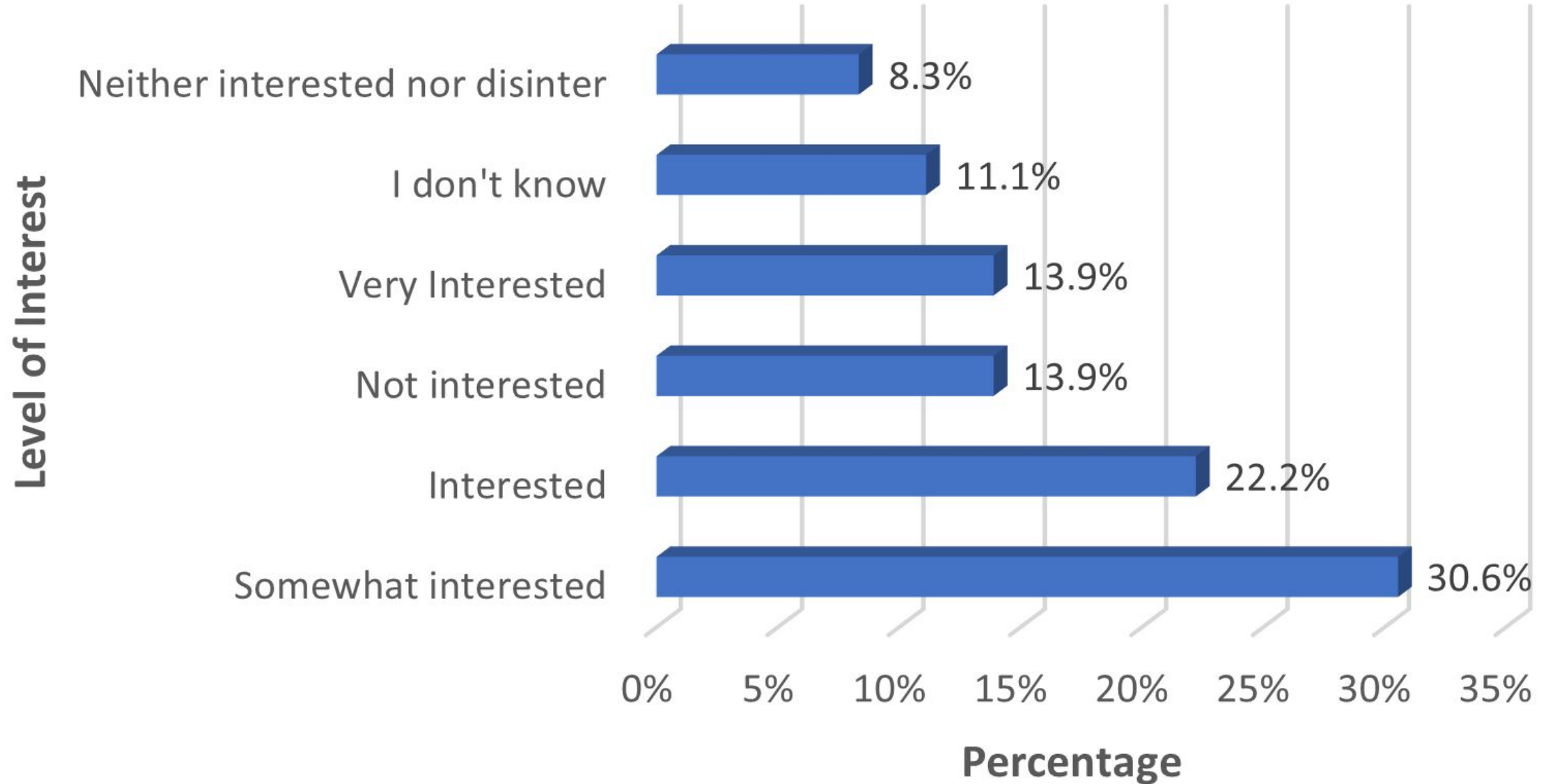
My Neighborhood Council's access to proper equipment



Hybrid Meetings: Interest, Barriers, Equipment Needs, and Special Accommodations

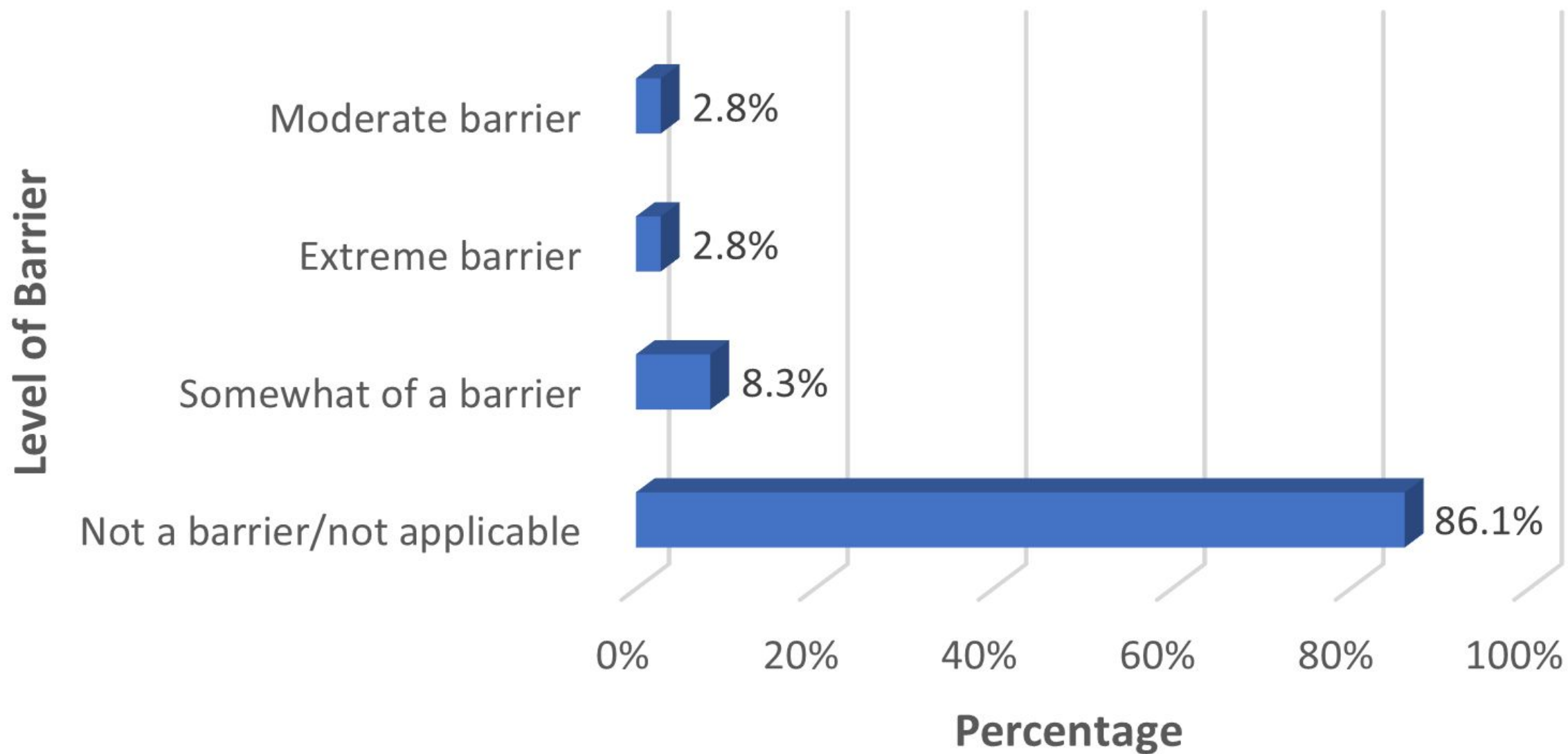
Hybrid Meeting Interest

Respondent's Board's interest in governing hybrid meetings

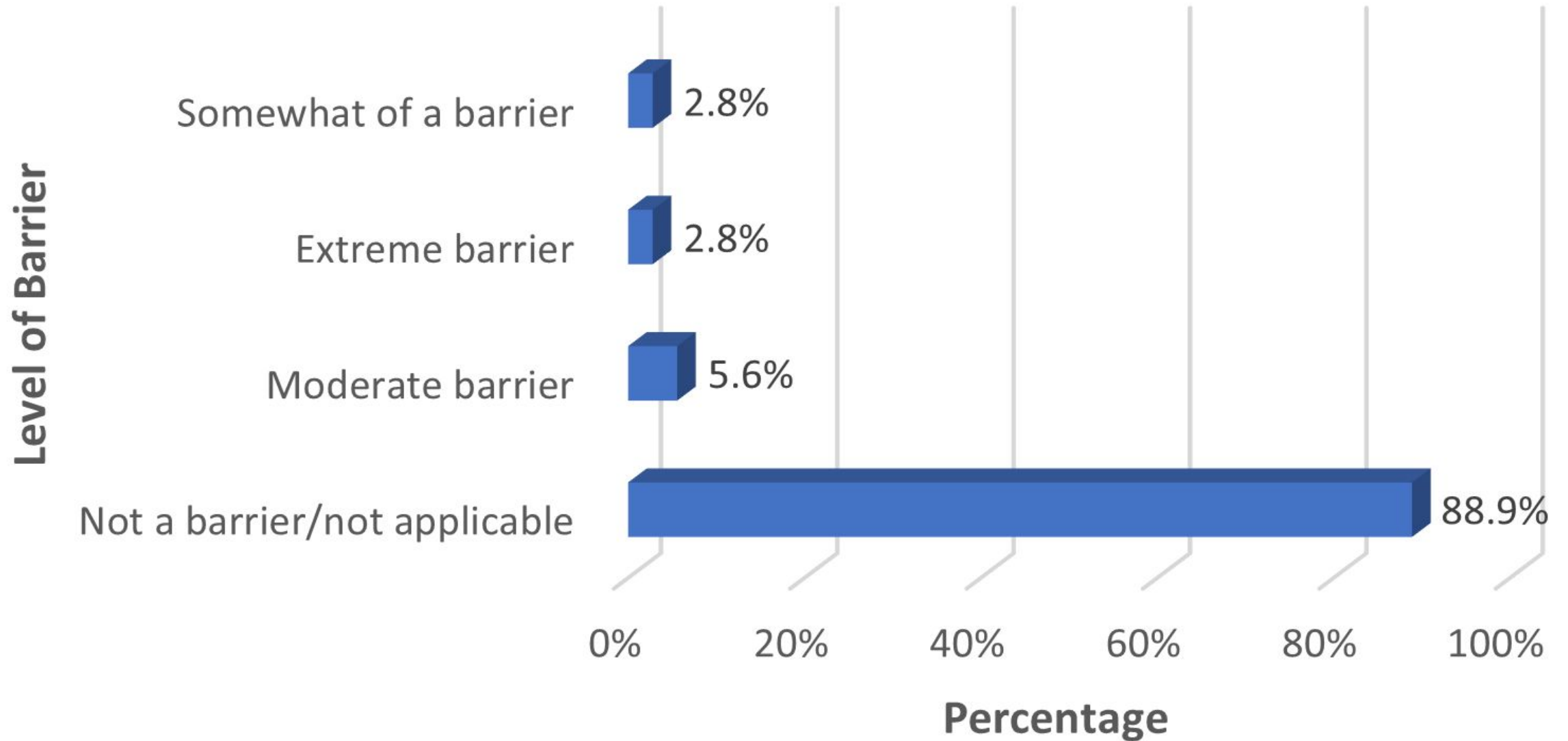


Hybrid Meeting Barriers

The quality of my internet connection (internet speed and stability)

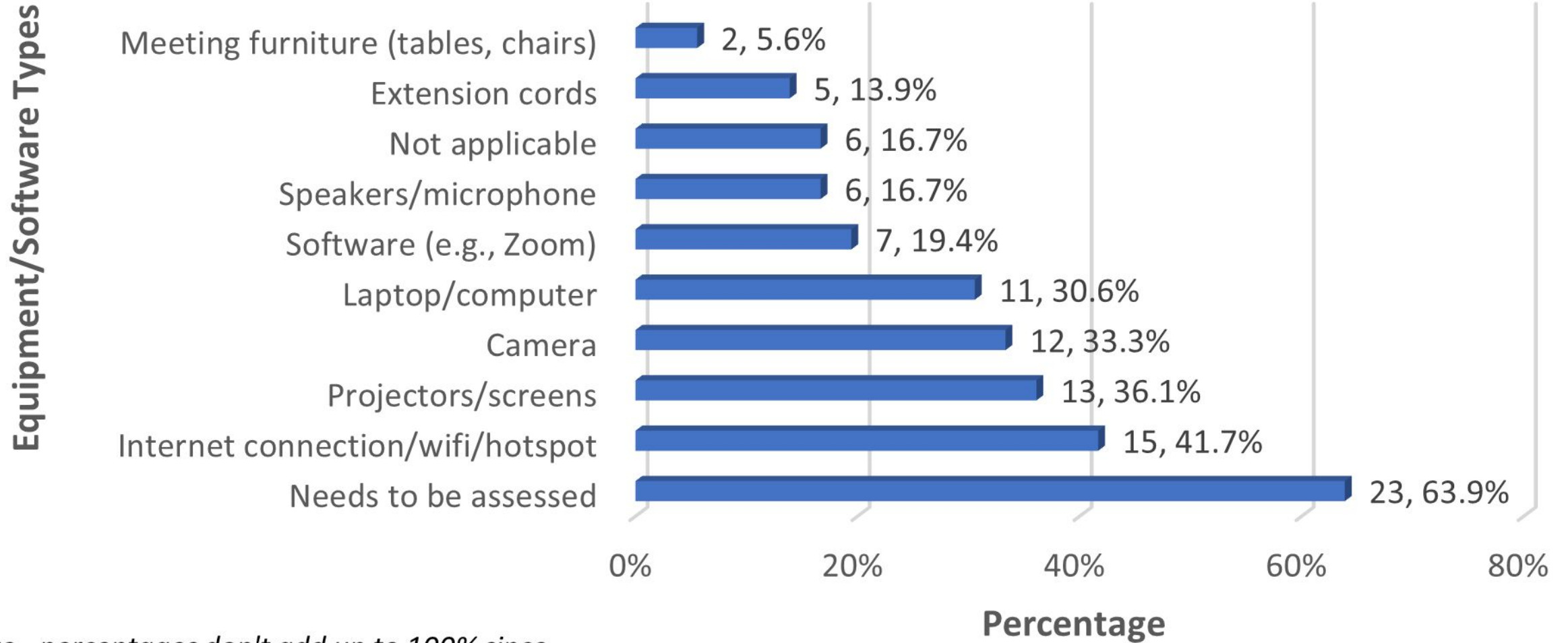


Access to devices required to participate (computers, tablets, mobile devices)



Hybrid Meeting Equipment Needs

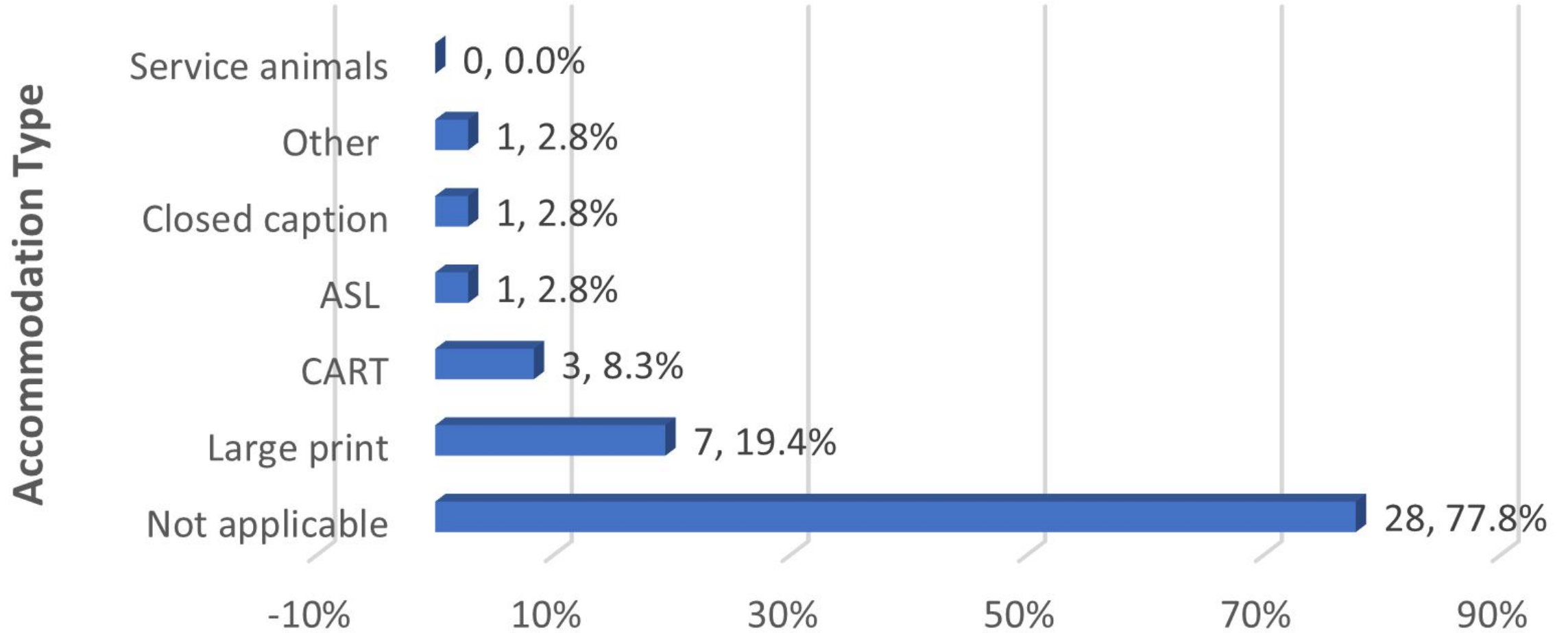
Neighborhood Council hybrid meetings equipment/software needs
